Minutes of Meeting for fixation of Landed Cost/Procurement/Sale rate of Vegetable Seeds for Kharif 2022 Season.

In response to the proposal submitted by Joint Director Agriculture (Inputs) Jammu vide No. JDA/Inputs/2021-22/2487-89 dated 31.12.2021 for fixation of procurement / Sale rate of Vegetable seeds for Kharif 2022, the meeting of the Designated Committee was held under the Chairmanship of Director Agriculture Production & FW, Jammu in his office Chamber on 07.01.2022. The meeting notice was circulated among all the members vide No. Agri./DAJ/Dev-42/2021-22/6075-83 dated 05.01.2022. The meeting was attended by the following officers:

The House was briefed by the Indenting Officer that as per the Minutes of the Meeting held on 06.04.2021 under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to Government, Agriculture Production & FW Department to finalize mode of procurement of seeds of Open Pollinated Varieties / Hybrids issued vide File No. Agri.-PS/24/2021-O/o Clerical Hall-AP & FW, dated 29.04.2021, wherein both the Directorates were authorized to procure vegetable Seeds directly from NSC as per the GoI guidelines issued from time to time.

Agronomist, Vegetable Improvement Scheme, Jammu informed the House that the availability status and procurement rates were sought from National Seeds Corporation Ltd. (NSC) vide communication Dev-7/2021-22/907-920 dated 01.12.2021 and Regional Manager, NSC Chandigarh had conveyed the availability along with rates of the Vegetable Seeds for Kharif 2022 Season vide communication Nos. III (Jammu)/Mktg/NSC-CHD/2021-22 dated 01-12-2021 and III(Jammu)/Mktg/NSC-CHD/2021-22 dated 14-12-2021. In compliance to the directions of the worthy Chairman & the Members of the Committee, Indenting Officer also approached different Seed Supplying Corporations viz NAFED, HIL,KVSS through email (Copies enclosed) to provide the availability status and supply rates of Certified / TL Vegetable seeds including spices.

None of the above Seed Supplying Agencies have been able to provide availability status & procurement rates of Vegetable seeds including spices (Certified/TL) except NAFED/NSC for supply during Kharif 2022 season. Head NSBD, NAFED through email has communicated the rates and availability of the vegetable seeds for Kharif 2022.

In view of the present Covid-19 Pandemic situation and sowing time approaching fast for the ensuing Kharif-2022 season, the Indenting Officer requested for early finalization of procurement / sale rates of vegetable seeds so that the seeds are made available to the farmers at an earliest for timely sowing.

In addition, Indenting Officer stated that seed distribution also involves subsidy and proposed 50% subsidy as per the guideline provisions of State CAPEX/CSS. It was also apprised that all the requisitioned varieties of vegetable seeds are in the supply chain of NSC/NAFED for last few years and are in demand by the farmers. The same was accepted by the Committee and it was agreed that the corresponding funds required will be provided to the Indenting Officer from appropriate heads (CAPEX/CSS).

The Committee was further briefed that there was also Farm Produced 260 Kg Vegetable Seed viz. Foundation Seed (F-II) of Bhindi (variety Okra-05) for which calculation sheet based on cost of cultivation was presented. It was advised by the Committee to propose average common procurement / sale rate for Farm produced vegetable seeds and seed to be procured through NSC. Therefore, clubbed average rate proposed for Bhindi (Okra-05) @ Rs. 303.00 per kg was worked out by the Agronomist (Vegetables) Jammu.
