## The release of funds is subject to the following conditions:

- i. The expenditure shall be made strictly as according to the classification under which funds have been authorized by the Finance Department.
- ii. Treasury Officers shall not entertain bill without complete classification under which funds have been authorized by the Finance Department.
- iii. DDO shall complete all the codal formalities before presentation of bills at the Treasury.
- Treasury Officer shall not allow parking or drawal of funds in the Civil Deposit without the prior concurrence of the Finance Department.
- v. Administrative Approval / Technical Sanction must have been accorded by competent authority wherever applicable.
- vi. The DDOs shall send status report about the scheme in terms of physical and financial progress made during the current financial year.
- vii. The department shall send Utilization Certificates (UC) of the funds as early as possible and positively before 31-03-2020 to GOI under intimation to Finance Department.
- viii. The DDO shall ensure that atleast 50% of the Budget allocation are earmarked for Small, Marginal Farmers of which 30% by Women Beneficiaries / Farmers. The guidelines issued by the competent authority in respect of persons with this ability may also be kept in view for disbursement of subsidy which may be intimated to this Department on monthly basis.
  - ix. All the sanctions / approvals and clearances shall be in place before drawal of money from the Treasury.
  - x. The DDOs shall incur expenditure strictly as per the guidelines of the scheme and the conditions laid down in the sanction letter of the concerned ministry of GOI.
  - xi. The funds shall be utilized strictly on the approved Work Plan 2019-20 on the activities authorized by the Govt. of India.
- xii. The Implementing agency shall ensure that the funds are utilized as per originally approved component and according to the guidelines of RKVY during 2019-20 and there is no duplication or overlapping of activities / areas covered.
- xiii. DDOs should adhere to the cost norms and pattern of assistance and adhere to the procedures as prescribed in the programme guidelines.
- xiv. The DDOs shall go for Asset Mapping with proper Geo Tagging for preparation of asset inventory. This will help the Govt.to start the process on asset insurance.
- xv. The DDO's shall furnish a status report about the scheme in terms of physical and financial progress made during the current year and up to date cumulative expenditure and physical achievement.
- xvi. The DDO's shall restrict the expenditure to the actual availability of funds and no liability shall be created in any case.
- The account shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Audit General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971, and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Officer of the Ministry or Department, where the State(s) / institution is called upon to do so.

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- The implementing agencies should identify SC/ST Beneficiaries amongst the total xviii. beneficiaries to achieve prescribed targets and book the amount of funds released for SC/STs and should invariable report the same on monthly basis.
  - The Department shall submit the utilization certificate, in the GFR- 12-C of the funds xix. at an earliest to this office for further submission to the G.O.I.
  - The MPR and cumulative MPR both physical & financial indicating its unit cost norms, XX. targets and corresponding achievements under various components is to be sent to this Deptt./ Adm. Deptt. and Govt. of India. It should indicate the achievement against the total amount.
  - Wherever Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) is involved, applicable guidelines including Aadhar xxi. Linkage shall be complied with strictly.
  - Treasury Officers shall not entertain bill without complete classification under which funds xxii. have been authorized.
  - The DDOs should strictly adhere to the conditions mentioned in the Sanction order issued by xxiii. GOI as referred to above. The funds shall be debited to the appropriate Head of Account as per BEAMS.
