

**Minutes of Meeting of Divisional Level Auction Committee (DLAC) of Directorate of Agriculture, Jammu held under the Chairmanship of Joint Director Agriculture (Inputs) Jammu, on 25/08/2020 in his Office chamber at Talab Tillo Jammu.**

In response to the Meeting Notice issued vide no. DAJ/Acctts/2020-21/768-771, dated 25-08-2020, Member Secretary briefed the members of Auction Committee that as directed by Director Agriculture Jammu, due to covid-19 pandemic and implementation of GFR-2017, eAuction was carried out and after due deliberations, following decisions were taken:

**1. Used unserviceable Gunny Bags**

On the basis of Auction request for Used unserviceable Gunny Bags by Research Engineer, Jammu, vide no. SP-1/2019-20/3245-47, dated 27-02-2020, and as per recommendations of Committee constituted vide Director Agriculture Jammu's Order no. 296-DAJ of 2019, dated 5-10-2019 for surveying of Gunny Bags wherein 50488 bags were recommended for auction and Joint Director Agriculture (Inputs), Jammu vide no. FS-16-1/2020-21/372-74 dated 09-05-2020 recommended the same.

Accordingly, Notice Inviting Auction (NIA) as a **Single-Lot** was uploaded on [www.eauction.gov.in](http://www.eauction.gov.in) Government of India portal vide no. DAJ/Acctts/NIA/2020-21/581-85, dated 04-08-2020, **Auction ID 2020\_JK\_2**. It was published in National Newspaper The Tribune, dated 06-08-2020 and Local Newspaper Daily Excelsior, dated 07-08-2020.

Before last date of submission, 5 firms participated online and also submitted requisite documents and EMD. Technical analysis of the submitted documents required for authorization of bidders was carried out by the Technical Committee constituted vide no. FS-III/2020-21/1370-74, dated 14-08-2020 and it recommended authorising following Five Firms for participation in eAuction to be held on 20-08-2020

1. M/s. Rajeev Rice Mills
2. M/s. Ram Sharnam Grinding Mill
3. M/s. Ganpati Agro Foods
4. M/s. Om Flour Mill
5. M/s. Kissan Sewa Kendra

After the auction time was over, online Single Lot Auction Sheet was downloaded and unmasking of firms was carried out. This sheet was presented before the Divisional Level Auction Committee, which awarded the Auction Contract to the highest bidding Firm M/s. Ganpati Agro Foods, who have quoted Rs 387440/00. It was also decided that in case H1 Bidder defaults on account of any Term & Conditions laid out in DNIA, EMD of H1 will be forfeited and Auction Contract will be awarded to H2 bidder.

**2. Leftover Seed Stocks/Rough Seed (Rejected) / Surplus and Undersized / Bi-products of Kharif 2017, 2018 (Produce) and Rabi 2017-18, 2018-19 (Produce).**

Joint Director Agriculture (Inputs), Jammu requested for Auction of Leftover Seed Stocks/Rough Seed (Rejected) / Surplus and Undersized / Bi-products of Kharif 2017, 2018 (Produce) and Rabi 2017-18, 2018-19 (Produce), vide no. JDA/FS-16-1/2020-21/01-03 dated 06-04-2020, and for fixing Basic Selling Price, a Committee was constituted vide no. FS-16-1/2020-21/833-37, dated 15-06-2020. On the recommendations of Basic Selling Price fixing Committee vide no. Agri/DAJ/Dev-28/2020-21/1226-27, dated 25-06-2020, Notice Inviting Auction (NIA) as **Multi-Lot** was uploaded on [www.eauction.gov.in](http://www.eauction.gov.in) Government of India portal vide no.

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DAJ/Accts/NIA/2020-21/576-80, dated 04-08-2020, **Auction ID 2020\_JK\_1**. It was published in National Newspaper The Tribune, dated 06-08-2020 and Local Newspaper Daily Excelsior, dated 07-08-2020.

Before last date of submission, 12 firms participated online and also submitted requisite documents and EMD. Technical analysis of the submitted documents required for authorization of bidders was carried out by the Technical Committee constituted vide no. FS-III/2020-21/1370-74, dated 14-08-2020 and it recommended authorising following 12 Firms for participation in eAuction to be held on 20-08-2020 to 21-08-2020

After the auction time was over, online Multi-Lot Auction Sheets were downloaded lot wise and unmasking of firms were carried out. Out of 25 lots uploaded for Auction, there was no participation and bidding in the Lot 1, Lot 12, Lot 15 and Lot 16. Auction sheets of all other remaining lots were presented before the Divisional Level Auction Committee (DLAC) and details of the highest bidding Firms are as under.

It was brought to the notice of DLAC that eAuction process was carried out for the first time in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir and due to lack of technical guidance/expertise, certain problems were encountered while evaluating auction bids which needed revocation/corrigendum. This issue was brought into the notice of Senior Programmers of NIC Mr. Sumit Kapoor and Mr. Deepak Bajaj, who approached NIC eAuction division and described the problem (Communication enclosed). In case of parallel portal of eTenders of GoI, there is availability of revocation/corrigendum option but due to newness of eAuction system, that option is not yet available on [www.eauction.gov.in](http://www.eauction.gov.in). Therefore, maintaining transparency and fairness and as per critical analysis of auction bids available on the portal, DLAC decided to award Auction Contract to highest bidders in all the auctioned lots and results along with Auction Sheets would be prominently displayed on the Directorates website [www.diragri.jmu.nic.in](http://www.diragri.jmu.nic.in), besides uploading on [www.eauction.gov.in](http://www.eauction.gov.in).


It was also decided that in case H1 Bidder defaults on account of any Term & Conditions laid out in Detailed NIA, EMD of H1 will be forfeited and Auction Contract will be awarded to H2 bidder. In case no H2 bidder is available, the unsold/un-lifted lot will go for re-auction.

Regarding the lots (No. 1, 12, 15 & 16) which remain unsold, DLAC decided to refer the matter to the Committee constituted for fixing Basic Selling Price vide JDA(I) no. FS-16-1/2020-21/833-37, dated 15-06-2020 which will analyse/ascertain the reasons and fix optimal applicable rates at an earliest so that these unsold remaining lots can be auctioned again through eAuction.
