On the recommendation of Departmental Purchase Committee regarding procurement of Maize, Paddy and Fodder hybrid seeds for the Kharif 2021, the rates have been finalized vide afore mentioned Minutes of Meeting


However, Rs 3.50 Per Kg (Rupees Three and half Per kg) shall be allowed as freight charges F.O.R. Central Store Lal Mandi Srinagar over and above the approved rates in respect M/s Proline Seeds Co. India Pvt. Ltd., M/s Kanchan Ganga Seeds and M/s Bharat Nursery.

The Indenting Officers shall ensure the rationalization of subsidy on seeds as per guidelines of the different Central/UT schemes and as per Revamped National Food Security Mission (NFSM) operational guidelines. Notwithstanding wide preference for certain hybrids older than 10 years, the indenting Officers will ensure that purchase of older than 10 years hybrid varieties will not be more than 20% of the total hybrid seed purchase, as provided in Revamped National Food Security Mission (NFSM) operational guidelines.

Further the Indenting Officers shall place the supply orders strictly as per the requirement of the Chief Agriculture Officers after entering in agreement with these Seed Companies.

The detail of the rate structures for Hybrid Maize, Paddy and Fodder seeds along with Terms and Conditions to be observed strictly for affecting procurement are given in Annexure A & B.

All the approved Rates (Annexure A) shall be governed by the Terms & Conditions specified in Annexure-B

1.	The Label on packing should indicate crop, variety, date of packing, validity, Germination percentage, purity percentage and also inscribed " J&K Government Supply ". However, keeping in view delayed approval of rates, first batch of supply F1 hybrid seeds may be exempted from inscription of " J&K Government Supply ".
2.	Rates approved are F.O.R Talab-Tillo Jammu inclusive of all taxes/ charges. However, Rs 3.50 Per Kg (Rupees Three and half Per kg) shall be allowed as freight charges over and above the approved rates F.O.R Central Store Lal-Mandi Srinagar (J&K).
3.	The quantity of seed to be supplied should be from disease free / fresh stock of seed.
4.	Rates approved by DPC of Agriculture Production & Farmers Welfare Department in no case shall be higher with any agency in J&K and adjacent States, if detected, the Principal Company will be blacklisted, besides forfeiture of CDR/FDR/Security money.
5.	Ten samples (Five for Jammu & Five for Kashmir) of each variety of Hybrid Seeds supplied will be drawn from each lot of supplies, the cost of which shall be borne by the successful supplier. They will put on to serve the purpose detailed below: Sample-1 To put on testing in seed Testing laboratory. Sample-2 Retained as referee sample with Indenting officer Sample-3 To be Retained with supplier Sample-4 To be put on trial in field by Department for Grow-out Test Sample-5 To be retained with Divisional Seed Certification Agency
6.	The M.R.P should not be lower than the approved rate and if detected in any case, the rate contract shall be terminated besides blacklisting of the company.
7.	Indenting Officers will send the copy of supply orders and testing report of each lot to Purchase Section, Directorate of Agriculture Jammu/Srinagar (J&K).
8.	Indenting Officer shall ensure that the conditions specified in the notice of invited offers should form a part of the contractual obligations in the agreement to be executed with the contractor.
9.	Left over seeds shall be collected at the District Store and shall be lifted back by the Joint Director of Agriculture Inputs Jammu/Kashmir from the District H.Q's to the central store for handing over to the same to the supplier before the end of the season as per the terms and conditions of the rate contract. The cost of lifting leftover stock from sale centres to District stores shall be borne by the Department.
10.	The rates approved by DPC shall remain valid up to ending September 2021.
11.	80% payment shall be made only after receipt/ verification/ SSTL report of hybrid seeds and balance 20% after Grow out Test Report or any other Test Report from National Accredited Labs. Payment shall be released by Indenting Officer only against GST billing.

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12.	AGREEMENT: A formal agreement deed incorporating the terms of the contract shall have to be executed by the successful tenderer/ authorized signatory with the concerned Indenting Officers on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs 20/- duly attested by registered Notary. The payment of the supplies will be made only on the basis of agreement deed. The stamp fee and all other charges in the preparation of two copies of agreement shall be borne by the supplier.
13.	All legal proceedings, if any, are subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts located in the Jammu city, of J&K UT.
14.	All other terms and conditions laid down in the GRF 2017 regarding supplies / Procurement of stores in Government Department shall be applicable.
15.	The successful firms shall have to deposit 5% of the total value of the order as security in the shape of CDR/FDR pledged to Joint Director Agriculture (Inputs) Jammu /Kashmir
16.	List of beneficiaries should be submitted to the Directorate of Agriculture Jammu / Kashmir by Chief Agriculture Officers concerned of both Divisions
17.	In case, the crop hybrids supplied by the company fails to produce desired result of crop yield, subject to variation of 5% against figures provided in respect of Hybrid Seeds, the company shall have to make good the losses suffered by the farmers besides the said variety /varieties shall be debarred for a period of three years.
18.	Firm has to supply the seed in desired packing and packing should be printed as per the provision of Seed Act 1966 and Seed Rules - 1968 and its amendment from time to time.
19.	Quantity given in the list for purchase is tentative and is subject to increase or decrease at the time of issue of supply order.
